



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF STATION ROAD, WEST MOORS
FOR REMEMBRANCE PARADE, 8TH NOVEMBER 2015 : Ref. 15/1090**

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH ROAD WAITING OR LOADING AND UNLOADING

For the purpose of a Remembrance Parade, DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of part of Station Road, West Moors by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event –

On Sunday, 8th November 2015 between 10.30 hrs and 12.00 hrs

The alternative route for diverted traffic (when the Parade has passed from the Riverside Road junction past the Farm Road/Moorlands Road junction) will be: From the northern end of the closure, via Moorlands Road, Braeside Road and Glenwood Road to the southern end of the closure. The reverse route applies.

Marshals will be stationed at strategic points to ensure only those taking part in the Parade and emergency vehicles have access.
