



## **GUIDANCE FOR USING THE PLAY AREAS.**

We would suggest that parents, guardians and carers bring hand sanitisers to the play area and advise that you use it when entering the play area and when you leave it.

We would suggest to parents, carers and guardians not to touch their faces, and to cough or sneeze into a tissue or arm when a tissue is not available.

We would suggest the use of anti-bacterial wipes for cleaning of equipment by users, parents, guardians and carers, particularly where there are clear touch points such as gates, swing rockers, see saws.

We would remind adults and children not to put their mouths on equipment or their hands into their mouths.

We would remind parents, guardians and carers of the need for social distancing.

Parents should not permit children to enter the play area unaccompanied, or when it is already occupied such that social distancing cannot be observed.

Eating and drinking in the play area is not permitted at this time.

Parents, guardians or carers should dispose of all litter including any used protective wear such as face coverings or gloves properly, by taking it home or placing in the bins provided. Disposable face coverings and gloves cannot be recycled.
